

OLD STYLE SIAMESE

Scale of points (see also General Preface)

<u>Head</u>	10	The head is rounded and in good proportion to the body.
<u>Muzzle</u>	10	The muzzle maintains the rounded contours of the head and is a modified wedge.
<u>Nose</u>	5	The nose has a slight dip at eye level.
<u>Ears</u>	5	Ears are medium, with a broad base and rounded tips, set as much on the top of the head as on the side.
<u>Eyes</u>	5	The top of the eye opening is slightly slanted with the bottom opening slightly rounded.
<u>Eye Color</u>	10	Blue with depth, brilliance and clarity preferred.
<u>Neck</u>	10	The neck is in proportion to the head and body.
<u>Body</u>	10	The body is medium to large in size with muscular development. Proportions are balanced with a solid appearance.
<u>Legs</u>	10	The legs are well-muscled, proportionate in length and bone to the body.
<u>Paws</u>	5	They are more round than oval.
<u>Tail</u>	10	It is medium in length, in proportion to the body, tapering and straight.
<u>Coat</u>	10	The coat is short, thick enough to have body, satiny and somewhat close lying, but not tight or flat. It is plush and soft in texture, and resilient to the touch.

PENALIZE Improper (i.e. off-color or spotted) nose leather or paw pads. Ticking or white hairs except in aging cats.

WITHOLD WINS For any evidence of illness or extreme poor health. Any eye color other than blue. White toes and/or feet. A wedge-shaped head with straight profile. A long, thin, tubular body. Long, thin legs, neck or tail.
