

SMOKE COLORS

BLACK SMOKE

So heavily tipped with jet black, it appears as a solid black cat, except for the lighter undersides (they may appear silver gray, shading down to white), the undercoat of white will not show until the coat is parted, other than for the white frill and ear tufts. Hair on legs, ears, feet and face shall be white next to the skin. **Eye color:** brilliant orange or deep copper. **Nose leather & paw pads:** black. Judges should allow for unsound undercoat in kittens.

BLUE SMOKE

Same as for the black smoke, except substitute blue for black. **Eye color:** brilliant orange or deep copper. **Nose leather & paw pads:** blue. Judges should allow for unsound undercoat in kittens.

BLUE-CREAM SMOKE (Smoke Blue-Cream)

White undercoat heavily tipped with blue, with clearly defined patches of cream. The cat appears as a blue-cream, but when in motion the white undercoat is apparent. Face, ears and legs are blue-cream with a narrow band of white next to the skin that may be seen when the fur is parted. (Very light to white ruff and ear tufts optional, not a fault). A blaze of cream tipping on the face is desirable. **Eye color:** gold to copper.

CALICO SMOKE (Smoke Calico)

Cat should be basically white with defined patches of red, cream and black tipped fur. The cat will appear to be a calico in repose, but when the fur is blown back or the cat is in motion, the white coming out from the roots of the fur will show. **Eye color:** gold to copper.

CAMEO SMOKE

Substitute red for black in the black smoke standard. **Eye color:** deep orange or deep copper. **Nose leather & paw pads:** pink. Judges should allow for unsound undercoat in kittens.

CHESTNUT SMOKE

White undercoat, deeply tipped with brown. Cat in repose appears brown. In motion, the undercoat is clearly apparent. **Nose leather & paw pads:** pinkish shade.

LAVENDER SMOKE

White undercoat, deeply tipped with frost-gray. Cat in repose appears frost-gray. In motion, the undercoat is clearly apparent. **Nose leather & paw pads:** lavender pink.

TORTOISEHELL SMOKE

The cat should appear as tortoiseshell in repose with a deeply tipped black, red and cream coat. Undercoat blends from creamish-white to white. White should also be apparent on the head, legs, ears and feet when fur is parted. **Eye color:** gold to copper. **Nose leather & paw pads:** may be rose, black or a combination of both. **Withhold wins:** lack of smoke undercoat on head, face, legs and feet; tabby markings; coat that appears to be more silver-cream than tortie-smoke.

SMOKE & WHITE

Any of the smoke colors with white. White on one-third of the body is desirable with four white feet and white on chest and stomach. There may or may not be a white blaze on the face or a white collar. **Nose leather & paw pads:** appropriate to tipping color, black, pink, or a combination of both.
