

ARTICLE XVI -- JUDGES, SHOW, AND REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Section 1. The Executive Board shall from time to time establish RULES GOVERNING CAT SHOWS, BREED STANDARDS, and RULES OF REGISTRATION, under which cat shows sanctioned by the Federation are to be held and to determine the basis on which various awards as approved by the Federation are to be made.
- Section 2. Changes in Breed Standards, Show Rules and Rules of Registration shall be placed in effect only at the beginning of a show season.
- Section 3. The Executive Board shall establish Rules for acceptance into and advancement within a Judging Program. These rules shall set the manner in which the judging program shall operate. This program shall be supervised by the office of the Judging Coordinator.
- Section 4. No judge may be an officer in any other organization having objects similar to those of this Federation. A judge holding a license from this Federation may participate as a guest judge for such other organizations as the Executive Board may determine.
- Section 5. If a judge resigns from CFF's judging program, any judging contract entered into by such judge, which calls for a judging assignment on or after the effective date of such resignation, shall immediately become null and void.
