

ARTICLE XVII – AMENDMENTS

- Section 1. This Constitution and By-laws may be amended by a vote of two-thirds majority of the membership present and voting at any meeting of the Federation, providing that the proposed amendment has been filed and circulated in the prescribed manner as set forth herein. An exception may be made if two-thirds of the total number of member clubs are present with a delegate or alternate, in which case additional proposals may be presented from the floor. These new items shall require a vote of two-thirds of the membership for passage.
- Section 2. At any special meeting of the Executive Board, the only business to be considered will be that which is circulated in the call of the meeting, unless two-thirds of the total number of member clubs are represented by a delegate or alternate, in which case the provisions for exception as enumerated in Section 1 of this Article shall apply.
