

## **ARTICLE V -- DUES AND OTHER DEBTS**

- Section 1. The annual dues for a member club shall be \$60.00 and shall be due and payable to the Second Vice-President of the Federation on or before February 1 of each year. Annual dues for a breed club shall be \$40.00 due and payable to the Second Vice-President of the federation on or before February 1 of each year.
- Section 2. A member club that fails to pay its dues and/or other debts to the Federation by the date they are due will be considered in arrears and shall not be entitled to participate in the proceedings of the Federation or to be granted a sanction for a cat show until such time as its debts to the Federation are paid in full.
- Section 3. A club in arrears for a period exceeding six (6) months shall be dropped from the roll of member clubs and the club shall be notified by the Treasurer that such action has been taken.
- Section 4. Reinstatement of a club dropped for reasons enumerated in this Article shall require the same procedures as for a new club applicant. Such reinstatement may not be made by mail ballot.
- Section 5. An applicant club accepted into membership when less than one-half of the fiscal year for dues remains shall be required to pay the full amount of the established dues for that year.
- Section 6. The annual dues for an individual member shall be \$45.00 and shall be due and payable to the Central Office by the anniversary date of acceptance as an individual member. Dues for additional family members are \$10.00 each and are due and payable to the Central Office by the anniversary date of acceptance as an individual member. Charter members of CFF who were in good standing as such on July 1, 1997 will observe an anniversary date of July 1 of each year.
- Section 7. Money owed to a CFF member club for any unpaid bills or NSF checks, with documentation, for any official CFF function, shall be reported to the Recorder. All Recorder's work for the person or persons will be suspended until receipt of payment is reported by the Club's Treasurer to the CFF Recorder.
- Section 8. Money owed to CFF itself by an individual for any unpaid bill or NSF check, with documentation, shall cause the Recorder's work for that person to be suspended until such bill is paid. POP awards will be withheld from any person who has an outstanding debt to CFF until such debt is paid.
