

## STANDING RULE #10 -- BREED CLUBS

---

1. Each breed of cat accepted for Provisional and Championship status should be represented on the Executive Board by a club representing that breed or color division or portion of a breed.
2. To be accepted as the representative club for a breed or color division or portion of a breed, a club must petition the Executive Board for such status (mail ballots will not be allowed), and the Board shall require that said petitioner club shall have included in its Constitution the following rules:
  - a) Membership shall be open to persons who breed and exhibit such cats as are properly the concern of the club on payment of annual dues not to exceed \$10.00 per person.
  - b) Acceptance into or expulsion from the club shall be by a two-thirds majority vote of the club members in good standing.
  - c) Voting on all matters pertaining to Standards, Registrations, and Show Rules shall be by a mail ballot of all members in good standing. In the case of an emergency when time will not permit voting by mail, a telephone ballot may be made.
3. Any person denied membership in a breed club may appeal to the Executive Board at its next regular meeting.
4. The recommendation of the Breed Club on proposals concerning its breed shall be referred back to the Committee on Rules for circulation to the member clubs together with the recommendation of both the Breed Club and the Committee on Rules.
