

STANDING RULE #16 -- INTERNATIONAL AFFILIATE

1. The Federation by mutual agreement with another independent organization of similar goals may enter into an arrangement for international affiliation.
2. Such affiliation shall include, but not be limited to:
 - a) Exchange of show rules and breed standards;
 - b) Exchange of judges subject to the requirements of each organization;
 - c) Exchange of Stud Book information and breeder listings;
 - d) Exchange of technical information regarding feline breeding, health and exhibition;
 - e) Exchange of awards.
3. Both organizations may display each other's logo, symbols, and trademarks with the words "International Affiliate" for the purpose of publicizing such arrangements.
4. Details of the manner and method of accomplishing the mutual activities above shall be determined, with the approval of the Executive Board, by a committee which shall include representation from the CFF Administrative Officers and a Liaison person to be the applicant affiliation, with the Administrative Officer as the Chairperson.
5. Because of the difference in procedural and regulator matters, equality in all areas of exchange may be difficult to attain. Concentration on similarities and whatever exchange can be accomplished in a spirit of international friendship should be stressed with the flow in either direction.
