<u>Head</u>	25	Short wedge. Ears: well-feathered, large, upright, and set fairly close together.
<u>Eyes</u>	10	Shape should be round, color should be light amber, rims should be pink-rimmed.
Body	10	Long but sturdy, legs medium in length; neat round feet with well-tufted toes. Male should be particularly muscular on neck and shoulders.
<u>Tail</u>	10	Full, of medium length.
Coat & Color	35	Fur should be long, soft, and silky to the roots. No wooly undercoat. The color should be chalk white with no trace of yellow. Auburn markings on the face with white blaze. Ears should be white; nose tip, pads, and inside of ears should be a delicate shell pink. The tail should be auburn in color with faint rings (in kittens, rings may be more distinct); an extension of the auburn color at the base of the tail is desirable.
		Objections: small auburn markings, irregularly spaced.
Condition & Balance	10	Well-balanced and healthy. Alert, affectionate and intelligent
